This contract is liable to be cancelled if either the contractor or any of his employees is found any time to be such a person who had not obtained the permission of the Government as aforesaid before submission of the tender or engagement in the Contractor's Service.

11. Eligibility Criteria

- a) The contractor should have at least completed one work of similar nature, the value of which should not be less than 1/5th of advertised cost as a prime contractor in anyone year during last five years.
- b) The contractor should have finance turnover of at least 40% of the advertised cost in any one year in the last 5 years. This should be duly audited by a Chartered Accountant.
- 12. Survey of nallah/road alignment shall be conducted by the contractor and the subsequently the proposals for L-Section and X-Section shall be submitted by the contractor to the DIQC for design purpose & one set shall be submitted in the office of Executive Engineer, Division-II, JDA, Nehru Market, Jammu
- 13. The contractor should have adequate trained supervisory staff in his establishment.
- 14. The contractor should have at least one Civil Engineer with diploma in Civil Engineering with three years experience or more or degree in civil engineering with two years experience or more in his establishment for each site.
- 15. The design finalised shall have to be got approved and vetted by the contractor at his own level either from the office of the Chief Engineer, Design Inspection and Quality Control, Jammu or from the Head of the Department of Civil Engineering Department of Govt. College of Engineering and Technology, Jammu.
- 16. The contractor shall conduct the entire requisite test as per the established engineering practices and codes and submit the test reports to the Engineer-in-Charge. All the tests shall be conducted by the contractor at his own cost.
